

### TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1) The course will be run with a minimum of 8 participants in the painting / cooking classes
- 2) Up to 16 participants (in total) will be accepted on each course. Places are reserved by paying a deposit of 150 Euros. Registration is on a first-come-first-serve basis (date of deposit)
- 3) On receipt of the booking form, bank details for payment of the deposit will be communicated. This deposit is only refundable in case the course has to be cancelled because of an insufficient number of participants (see point 1)
- 4) On receipt of the deposit, the organizers will confirm the course dates. Final confirmation will be sent out once the minimum number of participants (see point 1) is reached
- 5) The remaining fee (total course fee minus deposit) must be paid into the same account (see point 3) no later than 6 weeks before the start of the course
- 6) The fees minus deposit are refundable if a participant cancels in writing 6 weeks prior to the starting date of the course. We recommend that participants conclude an individual cancellation insurance so that all payments (deposit and fee) can be reclaimed in case of cancellation due to illness or other major events
- 7) Travel to and from Italy (Bari/Brindisi) is not included in the course fees. In case of course cancellation due to an insufficient number of participants (see point 1), no refund will be made for any pre-booked travel arrangements
- 8) No refund will be made if participants do not take part in excursions, dinners, etc., included in the price
- 9) Important: each participant is responsible for full travel, accident and medical insurance. The course organizers decline any responsibility for damage to persons and property
- 10) Room-mates (for double-room occupancy) will be assigned by the organizers, unless participants specify otherwise
- 11) The organizers reserve the right to provide alternative tutors / chefs or alternative accommodation (equivalent in quality) in case of unforeseeable circumstances
- 12) The organizers bear no liability for cancellation in the event of *force majeure* (natural disasters, acts of war, strikes, etc.)
